# CREATION

Production in the Swiss textile industry is at present being carried on at full capacity by reason of economic circumstances – the need to replenish stocks and the general demand for goods – which are known to all business men. Although there was a considerably increased home demand to be met in 1946, the textile industry participated to the extent of 22% in total exports together with those other Swiss industries which were predominantly interested in export trade. This very favourable juncture of affairs will be particularly noticeable at the approaching 31st Swiss Industries Fair in Basle. The textile industry will be represented at this manifestation with an unprecedented range and variety of exhibits, arising out of the preparation and working up of the raw materials, such as has never before been displayed at any of the 30 preceding Fairs.

In this way absolutely clear evidence will be forthcoming of the extremely important part which, in the opinion of authoritative business circles, is played by the Industries Fair in Basle by reason of its active promotion of the economic exchange of goods. Both the exhibitors and the Fair management have made all the necessary preparations for achieving, during the swiftly approaching eleven days of the Fair, a maximum of business contacts and the greatest possible publicity effect. These joint efforts derive powerful support from the present issue of the «Swiss Textile Review». There can be not the slightest doubt that, by its traditionally exemplary collaboration, this publication will make a most valuable contribution to the success of the 1947 Textile Fair.

### *More Textile Goods than Ever at the 31st Swiss Industries Fair*

The export pavilion which housed the «Creations» exhibit at the last Swiss Industries Fair made a great impression on visitors from near and far owing to the original way in which the valuable exhibits were displayed and the harmonious picture it presented, and it also brought to the Basle Textile Fair that international importance on which the management of the Fair intends to build up future participation.

By continuously adding more exhibition space efforts are being made to provide accommodation for all the exhibitors. The new building alongside Halls II and III, which will be partly ready for occupation in the spring of 1947, has already had two floors reserved for the technical groups and one for the textile and footwear exhibitors. On the one hand the various business sections have again been carefully concentrated and, on the other hand, every possibility has been taken into consideration with a view to making the best use in 1948 of the space available.

No fundamental changes have taken place in the big *Textile Hall II* either as regards the contents or the manner in which the goods are exhibited. The basic materials, with their semi-finished and finished products, will again be presented by representative Swiss firms. The collective exhibit of the woollen cloth manufacturers and the worsted weaving mills provides proof of the fact that, alongside of light, fashionable materials, Swiss-made



clothing materials have assumed a leading position in point of quality and design.

The «Creations» exhibit, the jewel of the Swiss Industries Fair, will be presented in an even more attractive setting. The latest creations – comprising St. Gall embroideries, printed materials from Zurich and Eastern Switzerland, silk ribbons from Basle, and the most exclusive models of footwear and millinery – have been grouped once again by the Basle graphic artist Donald Brun in such a quiet and distinguished atmosphere that they will not fail to make a profound impression on the visitor either from Switzerland or from abroad owing to the delicacy and elegance of their appearance and the inherent excellence of their quality.

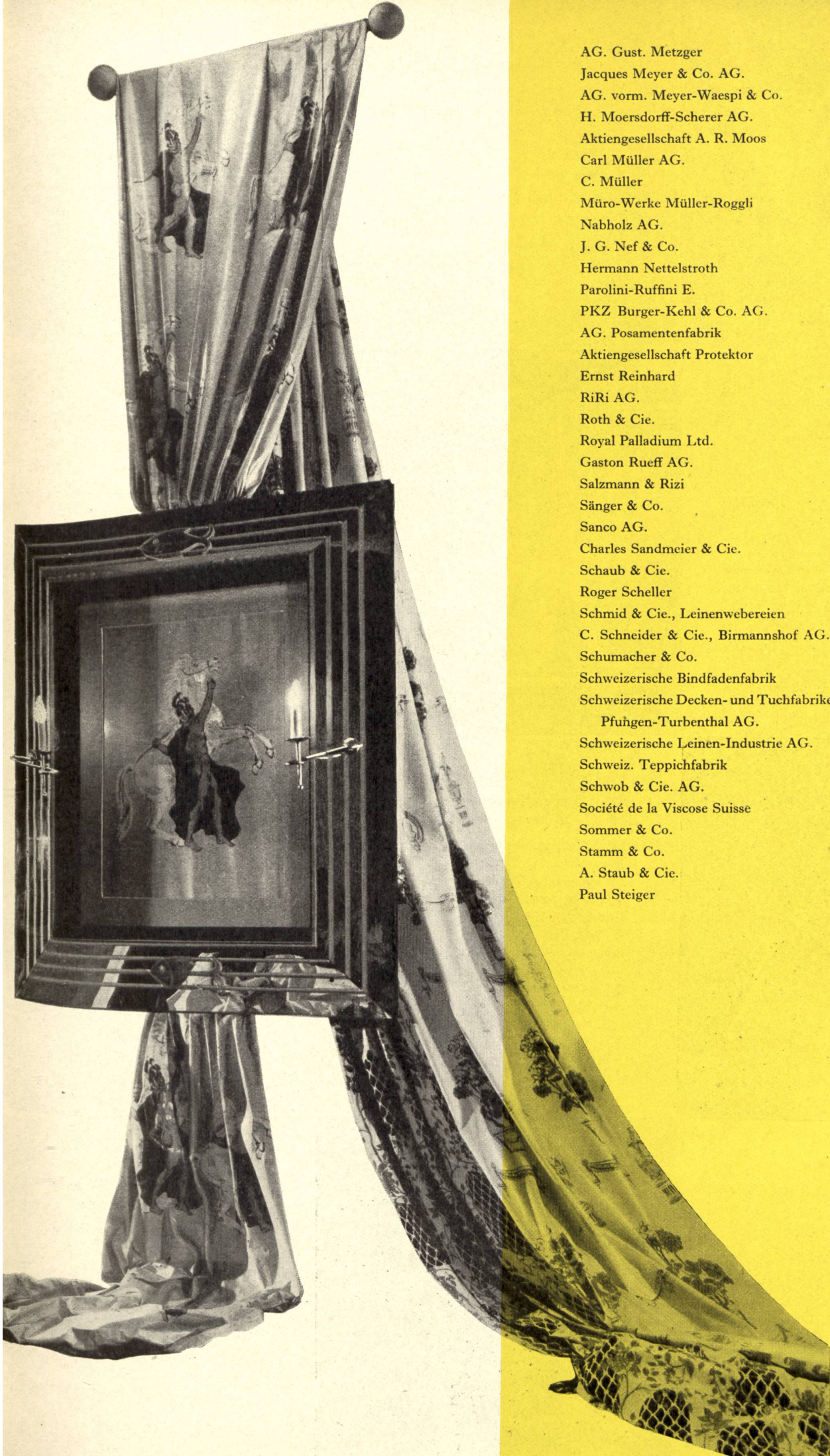
There will be a novel display of goods in the Textile Extension Exhibit on the first floor of the newly-erected Hall IIIb, which has just been completed at considerable cost, and where it is intended to house in 1948 the overflow from the Textile Group in Hall IIb. In addition to tastefully printed materials, fine-quality knitted underwear and heavy woollen piece-goods, there will be a special display of made-up clothing for ladies and gentlemen.

Every footwear manufacturer of importance in Switzerland will be represented this year at the Industries Fair in Basle. There will be an extensive exhibit of both fashionable and sporting type footwear in the right wing of Hall II and particularly on the first floor of Hall IIIb.

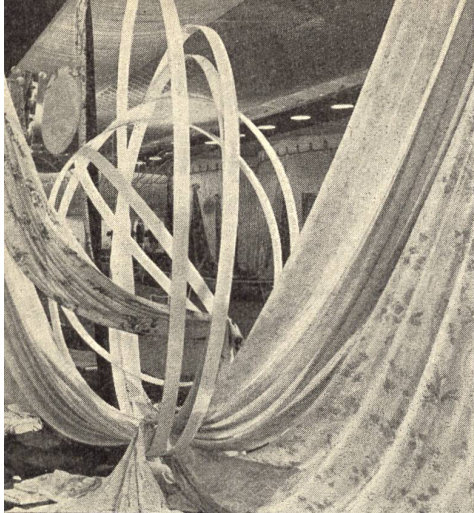
