


■■■ Success in our profession has to be seen in parallel with the other face of the same coin, failure. Success and failure make up a unity: they must be seen simultaneously. Success can never be regarded (or wished for) as a whole, exclusively. So many examples of creators that, in parallel with their triumph, the final liquidation of their inventive spirit, of that courage necessary for their work, suc-

ceeds. Neither do I retain as attractive this level of success, nor an absolute level of failure, because of its lack of motivation and its destructiveness.

I would not want to be regarded as a masochist by stating that failure is more exciting than success. Failure (or a certain level of it) is a feeling that motivates action, that leads to the fight; success involves inaction

(just as a lethal drug), muscle relaxation and a soft and annihilating feeling of complacency.

This is a mixture that every one must administrate. In my case, I try to put in parallel motivation to the action and the plausible hope towards a result, with the clear aim of keeping myself alive and excited in my participation in the inner forces that transform our reality.
