In the meantime an invitation has been received from the "Surrey County Rifle Association" to a friendly competition on Sunday, September 9th, at the Bisley Ranges. There are two competitions: one 300 yards on the Swiss Decimal target and the other 400 yards on the 300 yards match target. "CES MESSIEURS DE LA SANTE."

French film at the Academy Cinema, commencing Monday September 3rd.

Is it long since you have had the pleasure of seeing a really fine actor? Then go and see Raimu in "Ces Messieurs de la Santé." It would be a great pity if Hollywood became aware of the fact, but Raimu is a magnificent actor — fine voice — experienced mobile face — he really should not be lured to California and tempted to speak English dialogue — instead of the French language which he uses with such excellent effect.

"Ces Messieurs de la Santé" is a good film — it drags a trifle at the end — but no matter — Raimu is its hero — its villain if you will — Raimu is the film.

In this story of the financier who could not help — even without a cent of capital — being a financier — every rôle is played by people who really can act. Even the three extremely pretty actresses who supported Raimu can act.

The background of the story is Paris — the theme — highly immoral in the economic sense. It all depends on the dramatic point of view — Dickens in "Little Dorritt," made of such another as M. Tafard — a dull gross monster intimidated by his own butler — the authors of "Ces Messieurs de la Santé" have stressed the adventurous side of shady finance — but go and see Raimu as M. Tafard for yourself — and see whether you can maintain sufficient detachment to feel that it serves M. Tafard right when he discovers after launching the mining shares of Esteral — and selling them — that there really are mines in Esteral.
