The Academy Cinema, to which the foreign colonies living in London owe such a big debt of gratitude for the many delightful French and German films shown there, is now exhibiting a charming Austrian romantic comedy with the above title. It is based on a pre-war episode of Austrian army life that really happened. The young daughter of a famous family of high military distinction down the centuries is so disgusted with her brother's preference for music to an army career, that she takes it on herself to maintain the family tradition.

Under her brother's name, she joins the military academy, where her zeal and sportiness make up for her slight effminacy. For nearly three years she manages to keep up the deception, when the old enemy — love — begins to spoil the game. She falls desperately in love with the Adonis amongst her superiors, who himself begins to feel most alarmingly attracted by the rascally pretty young fellow officer. Fortunately, at the critical moment her father discovers the whereabouts of his daughter, and the story ends in the happiest possible solution. The acting is done most beautifully throughout, and in particular by the heroine, Dolly Haas. The filming is done with taste, unpretentious, but charming.
