MORE THAN 100 YEARS OF CONFIDENCE Swiss Life introduces International Group Insurance Services in the U.K.

On 26th September, Swiss Life and Pension Company, Switzerland's oldest and largest insurance company underwriting life business ("Rentenanstalt"), formally announced the opening of its U.K. Branch which has offices in Liverpool and the City of London.
